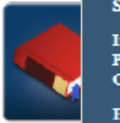

**Addresses requests to deviate from the Office of Detention and Removal's (HQDRO) Enforcement Standard pertaining to the escorting of aliens in custody where strict compliance with the policy is impossible or impractical. Requests for any such deviation will be considered by HQDRO on a case-by-case basis, and HQDRO will make the final determination as to whether deviation from the policy is permitted in a particular case. No deviation from the escort policy is permitted without express approval from HQDRO in the specific case.**
