Login	1. Enter the URL for the RevCom of interest:
	a. <u>www.directives.doe.gov/login.jsp</u> (Directives)
	b. <u>www.standards.doe.gov/login.jsp</u> (Technical Standards)
	c. <u>www.directives.nnsa.doe.gov/login.jsp</u> (NNSA)
	d. <u>www.lanl.revcom.doxcelerate.com/login.jsp</u> (LANL).
	2. Click on Reviewers/Subject Matter Experts.
	3. Enter your e-mail address. No password needed.
	If you have not used RevCom before or if you have a new e-mail address, RevCom will prompt you
	to select your organization from a list provided.
Review the Draft	1. In the <b>Document List</b> , select the process (e.g., <b>Review and Comment/Concurrence</b> , etc.) in the
and Make	bar at right of the title
Comments	NOTE: The <b>Document for Review</b> (a PDF of the draft) is available at upper right in the open
	document.
	2. Select from the <b>Section List</b> at left a section for your comments.
	3. Below each paragraph of interest, click <b>Add Comment</b> .
	a. Classify your comment as Major/Essential/Substantive or Minor/Suggested/ Editorial.
	b. For a <b>Major/Essential/Substantive</b> comment, briefly define the issue in the box provided.
	c. Use the <b>Editing Tools</b> to comment or suggest text revisions.
	d. Use the <b>Copy Text</b> option to load the text from the paragraph and make editorial changes.
	e. Click on <b>Save</b> to keep the comment or on <b>Cancel</b> to delete it.
	4. Click <b>Add Comment</b> for <i>each</i> comment. Select <b>Add Comment</b> <i>multiple times to make multiple</i>
	comments, to enable the writer to respond to each comment.
	5. You do not have to enter all comments in one sitting. <b>Exit</b> RevCom to continue later.
	4. For reviews where you are to answer a question, choose <b>Answer Question</b> and select from
	the available options.
Submit your	1. Click <b>Submit</b> when finished.
comments	You can re-submit your comments or change your question response until your due date.
	2. You can choose from available <b>Notification Options</b> and add comments to the notification
	(optional).
	3. Choose either <b>Submit Package</b> or <b>No Comments</b> .
	6. RevCom will notify you that your comment or question response has been submitted.
Get Reports	1. On the <b>Document List</b> page, to find a specific document that was processed in RevCom,
	enter title or number in the <b>Search</b> box. The display will include RevCom postings back to the
	first entry.
	2. In an open document, choose the <b>Reports</b> menu.
	3. Choose <b>Quick</b> to select from a list of standard reports.
	a. <b>My Organization Comments</b> includes comments posted by your organization (Delegates,
	SMEs, Reviewers, and the organization).
	b. All Comments includes comments submitted in the final comments package by all
	organizations assigned to the review.
	c. <b>Comment Disposition</b> includes writers' submitted responses to comments in your
	organization only.
	d. <b>Answers Table</b> includes responses to questions (concurrence, PJS, etc.).
	e. Questions/Answers Graphics displays the question responses in graphic format.
	f. <b>Answers Summary</b> displays the question and answer options with percentages of users
	selecting each choice.

Get Reports	g. Answers Details Classic displays responses to the question listed by organization.
(cont'd)	h. Answers Details Table shows answers according to organization.
	i. Click on <b>Custom</b> to build your own report.
	4. To find the submissions for a specific document:
	a. In the <b>Reports</b> menu, select <b>Monitor</b> .
	b. Select a document from the list provided.
	c. The list includes due date, submission status, and types of comments.
	5. To find writer response to submitted comments:
	<ul> <li>In the open document, select Reports and choose Comment Disposition. That will display your comments' submission movement from your organization to the author and submitted responses.</li> </ul>
	b. <b>Acceptance Report</b> to see a listing by organization with the option to display the list by document or users who submitted comments; or
	4. In the <b>Reports</b> menu, select <b>SME Main Contributors</b> . In the <b>Search SMEs</b> list, enter a
	document title or SME name, and choose a date range.
